1. Call to Order & Establish a Quorum:
  - a. **5** of 9 voting members were present – Quorum **was** established.
2. Approve Minutes
  - a. Minutes **were** approved from the June 2025 Meeting by Unanimous Vote.
3. Citizens Comments:
  - a. No Comments
4. Commissioner Jennifer Milele/Art Giles: Updates on City Projects, Changes, Comments, etc.:
  - a. City budget was passed.
  - b. Taxes went up, but not as much as it could have been.
5. Grant Status/Opportunity/Updates – Public Works:
  - a. One State grant is currently open – Statewide Partnership Program.
    - i. Trying to get funding for Lebanon Rd Widening
    - ii. From Park Glen to West Elementary.
    - iii. Total cost could be near \$50M.
6. Woodridge Sidewalk Ribbon Cutting Recap:
  - a. Mike E. said it was a very nice ribbon cutting.
  - b. It was hot, but there was a sizeable crowd.

- c. Art asked Justin to make a video for the City about the sidewalk.
    - i. The video could include that the City only paid for a portion of the sidewalk as the rest was covered by a development and also by a Safe Routes to School Grant that paid 100% of the cost.
  - d. It provides connectivity from Mt Juliet Rd to Golden Bear, many people don't realize that it exists.
- 7. Annual Greenway Walk Discussion & Brochure:
  - a. August 14th (Thursday) Rainout will be August 28th
  - b. Starting at 6pm
  - c. Route was chosen:
    - i. Athlete's Way Trail that Steve A. mentioned
    - ii. There is a trail head across from Amazon located at the light.
    - iii. Steve measured the two options, one is 2.25 miles the other is 2.75 miles.
      - 1. Majority was in favor of the 2.75 miles.
    - iv. Steve is working on the Flyer now that the route option was decided.
- 8. Discussion: Identify Areas of City for Ped Connectivity and/or Repairs
  - a. Matt R asked if the email was set up by Travis for these items to be submitted by citizens. – The email was created and added to the BPAC page of the City website.
  - b. The trailhead parking lot has been completely full along Golden Bear and people are parking on the grass. If it could ever be expanded, it would be welcomed.
    - i. Art encouraged others to photograph how full the parking lot gets.
    - ii. The HOA for Jackson Hills owns the trail head
  - c. Matt W. said if you see anything to let PW know and he can have his group look into it.

  - b. Participation at the State Fair has been postponed and BPAC won't be needed.
