A RESOLUTION DECLARING CITY OF MT. JULIET FIRE DEPARTMENT PROPERTY AS SURPLUS TO BE DONATED TO OVERTON COUNTY EMA

WHEREAS, the City of Mt. Juliet Fire Department has certain property that has reached the end of its useful life; and

WHEREAS, the property includes: 27 Self Contained Breathing Air (SCBA), 30 SCBA face masks, 20 SCBA packs; and

WHEREAS, this property has been replaced by newer equipment and is of no further use to the City; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has elected to donate the property to Overton County EMA; and

WHEREAS, this donation will assist Overton County and foster goodwill between our agencies.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee as follows:

Section 1. The property listed is hereby declared to be surplus property.

Section 2. The property shall be donated to the Overton County EMA.

Section 3. The City Finance Director is empowered to execute the documents required to effect this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED

In case of conflict between this resolution or any part hereof, and the whole part of any existing resolution of the City, the conflicting resolution is repealed to the extent of the conflict but no further.

If any section, clause, or provision or portion of this resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, or provision or portion of this resolution.

This resolution shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
