**Minutes**

1. Call to Order & Establish a Quorum:
  - a. **7** of 9 voting members were present – Quorum **was** established.
2. Approve Minutes
  - a. Minutes **were** approved from the March 2025 Meeting by unanimous vote.
3. Citizens Comments:
  - a. Sally Robertson made some comments.
    - i. Tia’s Botique asked to design a towel for the cause.
      1. Could potentially sell towels as a fundraiser and give a portion back.
    - ii. Speed Limit on Mt Juliet Rd is too high.
      1. As an aside: This isn’t a BPAC issue.
      2. This is a state route so it needs to be handled by the state.
4. Commissioner Jennifer Milele: Updates on City Projects, Changes, Comments, etc.:
  - a. Commissioner Milele asked about the status of scheduling the greenway walk.
    - i. Still open for discussion. Will be further discussed in May.
  - b. Commissioner Milele asked if the July meeting was still occurring. Matt R stated that it needed to be determined based on the timeframe of the Greenway walk.

5. Grant Status/Opportunity/Updates – Public Works:
  - a. Mt Juliet Sidewalk Improvements later this year or early next week
  - b. Lebanon Rd Sidewalks Phase 3 is going into construction next fiscal year (July 2025 – July 2026).
  - c. Woodridge Sidewalks: Progress is ongoing. They will place bridges, then boardwalk then sidewalk. Target for end of May – but likely won't include punch list completion.
    - i. Ribbon Cutting Discussion: After entire project is complete.
  - d. No update available on Grant funding for Belinda Pkwy.
  - e. Previous updates:
    - i. Belinda Parkway grant submission is still under review and PW has not had any response yet on the award.
    - ii. Woodridge Sidewalk Update: There is a major delay in the project based on the location of a bridge foundation and a conflict with the water main.
    - iii. Ribbon Cutting Discussion:
      1. When the projects are completed we can discuss doing a ribbon cutting. This can be discussed in the April Meeting.
    - iv. SS4A Steering Committee Update: Matt Richardi stated that the next Safe Streets 4 All Steering Committee meeting is scheduled for Thursday, March 6th, in the afternoon. The meeting is to discuss the Draft Safety Action Plan developed for the City. The Steering Committee received the draft document on February 21st.
6. Walk Across Wilson Discussion:
  - a. Event is well underway and will end April 19th
  - b. This Saturday (4/5/25) is the Heartwalk at Cumberland University. Program begins at 9 and walk starts at 9:30. Team Members can gather for a group photo between 8:15 and 8:45 – Every Team Member in the photo will earn an additional 200 bonus minutes for their team.
    - i. The whole team is a slacker and they don't care about hearts.
