A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MT. JULIET, TENNESSEE, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENTS BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF MT. JULIET AND THE PARENT COMPANY FOR PAVING SERVICES

- **WHEREAS,** The City of Mt. Juliet Board of Commissioners approved an amendment to the contract with The Parent Company, Inc. for paving services related to the new Police Department Headquarters; and
- **WHEREAS**, the new parking lot would add 30 additional parking spaces to the overall site plan; and
- **WHEREAS**, The Parent Company initially estimated the construction costs would not exceed \$550,000 for the paving services related to the parking lot; and
- **WHEREAS**, due to increasing prices the cost of the actual paving services has increased to \$649,273 and;
- **WHEREAS,** The Board of Commissioners desires to accept the final paving change order and approve the amendment to the agreement.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City of Mt. Juliet, Wilson County, Tennessee as follows:
- **Section 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an amendment to the agreement by and between the City of Mt. Juliet and The Parent Company for paving services of \$649.273.
- **Section 2.** In the event of conflict between this resolution or any part hereof, and the whole or part of any existing resolution of the City, the conflicting resolution is repealed to the extent of the conflict but no further.
- **Section 3.** If any section, clause, provision, or portion of the resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of the resolution.

This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law, the public welfare requiring it.
