**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO GRANT A RETAIL LIQUOR STORE CERTIFICATE
OF COMPLIANCE TO _____ (OWNED BY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Code Chapter 4, Article IV, Section 4-97, the City is authorized to issue two new retail liquor store certificates of compliance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mt. Juliet Alcohol Beverage Board met on November 12, 2024 and considered this applicant and recommended this applicant to the City of Mt. Juliet Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Mt. Juliet Board of Commissioners desires that the Mayor grant a certificate of compliance to _____, which is owned by _____ and located at _____, Mt. Juliet, TN 37122.

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Code Chapter 4, Article IV, Section 4-94, retail liquor stores are restricted from being within three drivable miles from another liquor store. The remaining two applicants are within three miles of the retail liquor store being granted a certificate of compliance by this Resolution. Therefore, the Mt. Juliet Board of Commissioners desires to deny the remaining two applicants based on their location violating Section 4-94.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City of Mt. Juliet, Wilson County, Tennessee as follows:

Section 1. The City of Mt. Juliet Board of Commissioners hereby requests that the Mayor grant a retail liquor store certificate of compliance to _____, which is owned by _____ and located at _____, Mt. Juliet, TN 37122.

Section 2. The City of Mt. Juliet Board of Commissioners, pursuant to City Code Chapter 4, Article IV, Section 4-94, hereby denies the retail liquor store certificate of compliance applications submitted by _____ and _____.
