

RESOLUTION 2026 –

A RESOLUTION TO RATIFY AND CONFIRM APPROVAL OF THE AGREEMENT WITH PIPEWORKS PLUS FOR EMERGENCY SEWER REPAIR SERVICES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 22, Section 6-22-129 of the Charter of the City of Mt. Juliet and City Ordinance No. 2018-08, the City has adopted policies and procedures governing the emergency expenditure of funds in excess of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the City Manager determined that emergency repairs to the sewer line located along North Mt. Juliet Road at Old Pleasant Grove Road were necessary following overflow events occurring in December 2025 and a subsequent investigation revealing urgent deficiencies in the size of the line and the capacity; and

WHEREAS, on January 29, 2026, three members of the Board of Commissioners, including Mayor Maness, Vice Mayor Trivett, and Commissioner Milele, individually approved the emergency agreement and authorized the associated expenditure of funds in accordance with the City's emergency expenditure policy; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager thereafter executed an Agreement with Pipeworks Plus for the emergency sewer repair services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners now desires to formally ratify and confirm the approval and execution of said Agreement with Pipeworks Plus by Resolution.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee as follows:

Section 1. The execution and approval of the Agreement with Pipeworks Plus, attached hereto as Exhibit A, for the emergency sewer repair services, is hereby ratified, approved, and confirmed in all respects.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED

In case of conflict between this resolution or any part hereof, and the whole part of any existing resolution of the City, the conflicting resolution is repealed to the extent of the conflict but no further.

If any section, clause, or provision or portion of this resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, or provision or portion of this resolution.

This resolution shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
