ORDINANCE 2024 -

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ABANDONMENT OF A PORTION OF THE EXISTING ROW OF RUTLAND DRIVE NEAR GOLDEN BEAR GATEWAY.

WHEREAS, The City of Mt. Juliet Board of Commissioners desire to abandon 7,785 square feet of existing ROW along Rutland Drive near Golden Bear Gateway, as depicted in the attached exhibit.

WHEREAS, The City of Mt. Juliet Regional Planning Commission will consider this Abandonment on November 21, 2024 and give a recommendation prior to the 2nd reading of this ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF MT. JULIET, TENNESSEE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS:

- **Section 1.** In case of conflict between this ordinance or any part hereof, and the whole or part of any existing ordinance of the City, the conflicting ordinance is repealed to the extent of the conflict but no further.
- **Section 2.** If any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance.
- **Section 3.** That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law, the public welfare requiring it.
