RESOLUTION 2025 –

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE MUNICIPAL TECHNICAL ADVISORY SERVICE TO PROVIDE A COMPLETE CODE SERVICE FOR THE CITY OF MT. JULIET CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the Municipal Technical Advisory Service (MTAS) offers a complete municipal code service that provides, in part, the recodification, revision, organization, and legal review of current municipal ordinances/code; and

WHEREAS, the complete code service is recommended to be completed every ten (10) years, and the City of Mt. Juliet has not undergone such a service since April of 2010.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee as follows:

Section 1. The City requests the Municipal Technical Advisory Service to revise and codify the ordinances of the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee, at the earliest possible date.

Section 2. The City agrees to pay the Municipal Technical Advisory Service \$14,500.00 for the revision and codification of its ordinances based on the current population of 40,289. At least fifty percent (50%) of the cost must be paid when ordinances are requested for codification and any remaining amount must be paid no later than upon delivery of the first draft of the municipal code.

Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to execute all necessary documents related to the MTAS complete code service.

This Resolution shall take effect after final passage.
