

RESOLUTION - 2026

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AN ADDENDUM TO THE SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH AMBULANCE MEDICAL BILLING (AMB) FOR BILLING SERVICES RENDERED BY THE MT. JULIET FIRE DEPARTMENT AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners previously approved a Service Agreement with Ambulance Medical Billing (herein after referred to as "AMB") on October 24, 2022 (Resolution 71-2022) for EMS and fire billing services rendered by the Mt. Juliet Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners now desire to approve an addendum to the Service Agreement with AMB to extend the agreement term an additional three years; and

WHEREAS, AMB shall continue to use commercially reasonable efforts to bill for and obtain reimbursement for the City of Mt. Juliet Fire Department for Emergency Medical Services rendered by the Department by billing patients, third-party payers, including applicable governmental programs and entities; and

WHEREAS, AMB will provide the necessary software, computer equipment and training of the City of Mt. Juliet Fire and EMS Personnel at an estimated value of \$89,578.50 and AMB will retain 10.15% per month of net collection received during this term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee as follows:

Section 1. The attached addendum to the service agreement with Ambulance Medical Billing is approved.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute said addendum.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED

In case of conflict between this resolution or any part hereof, and the whole part of any existing resolution of the City, the conflicting resolution is repealed to the extent of the conflict but no further.

If any section, clause, or provision or portion of this resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, or provision or portion of this resolution.

This resolution shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
