Jaya Joshi, partner and majority owner of Jalsa One, LLC d/b/a The Pub, appeared before the Board. She stated that the business intends to sell beer, liquor, and food as a full-service restaurant, located in the former "CP Between the Lakes" building. The establishment anticipates employing between 15-20 staff members, and all employees will obtain the necessary alcohol server permits. Ms. Joshi noted that there are three partners in the LLC, and she is the majority owner.

She explained that they plan to retain the same staff from CP Between the Lakes and will assess staffing needs as operations progress. The ownership change will officially take place approximately one week after the required beer permits and licensing are approved.

Chairperson Scales asked how the establishment plans to prevent sales to minors. Ms. Joshi stated that the previous owner will assist with training for approximately one month, and that they have a structured training program and employee handbook in place.

Board Member Usry asked about the policy for checking IDs at the table. Board Member Christenson explained previous violations and the potential consequences. Usry further explained that the Mt. Juliet Police Department conducts random compliance checks.

Vote: Yea Unanimous, with the exception that CP Between the Lakes must first turn in its existing beer permit prior to issuance of the new permit.

A motion was made by Board Member Usry, seconded by Board Member Christenson, that this application be approved. The motion carried by the following vote:

Owner and operator were present and spoke regarding the application. They stated the business will utilize a state-of-the-art POS system, require ID checks for all alcohol sales, and enforce a zero-tolerance policy for selling to minors. Mandatory training will be provided to all employees on proper ID verification procedures.

Chairperson Scales asked about the POS system and whether there is a bypass option. The applicant stated that while a bypass exists, employees are required to manually enter the customer's birth date each time, even for regular customers, to ensure IDs are checked.

Board Member Christenson asked how many employees the business will have. The applicant responded that there will be four to five employees, all of whom will complete mandatory alcohol server training.

Applicant noted they have until November 7 to finalize permits until they take over ownership of the store.

Vote: Yea unanimous, contingent upon the current ownership turning in its existing beer permit prior to issuance of the new permit.

Douglas Waterman, attorney, and the business owners were present. They stated they are currently applying for a beer permit only, with plans to apply for a liquor license at a later date. The business has been open for approximately five months but has not yet been able to serve beer.

Board Member Usry asked why there was a delay in applying for the permit. The applicants explained that they had been waiting to receive necessary documentation.

The owner stated that the business utilizes a Clover POS system and explained how it functions. All servers will be required to obtain their ABC licenses, and all current hires have five or more years of industry experience. The owner further explained their business concept, noting that they offer an extensive food menu and plan to include live entertainment.

Chairperson Scales explained the City's random compliance checks and the consequences for violations.

Details:

On 05/21/2025 at approximately 1210 hours, detectives with the Mt. Juliet Police Department's Crime Suppression Unit conducted an on-site alcohol compliance check at Martin's BBQ Restaurant, (200 Crossings Ln).

Utilizing an adult underage confidential informant (CI); detectives provided the CI with \$10.00 of Official Advance Funds (OAF) and briefed the CI about the operation. A short time later, the CI entered Martin's BBQ and was able to successfully purchase a canned Michelob Ultra for \$4.94. The CI's ID was checked and a purchase was still made as observed by audio/video recording. Once the transaction was complete, the CI exited the restaurant and described the offender (Mary Vogel) to detectives. The CI stated the offender was a white female with blonde hair coming out the sides of a gray and white hat and Martins BBQ work attire. The receipt also reflected the sale.

After speaking with the CI and gathering all information, Detective Bates and I entered the establishment and made contact with Mary. Mary was subsequently issued a misdemeanor citation for violation of TCA 57-4-203 Prohibited Practices. Her booking date was set for Wednesday, June 11th, 2025, at Wilson County Jail. I advised Mary of the court process and she stated she understood.

- Audio and video evidence collected during this event was processed and submitted to the Mt. Juliet evidence custodian and uploaded to Polaris. The purchase receipt is attached to this report.

RE: Mandatory Appearance Before the Mt. Juliet Alcoholic Beverage Board

Dear Permit Holder:

You are hereby cited to appear before the Mt. Juliet Alcoholic Beverage Board on December 9, 2025, at 5:30 PM. You will have the opportunity to explain the circumstances why your beer permit should not be suspended or revoked for violation of the Mt. Juliet City Ordinances. Specifically, Section 4-70(3):

"Make or permit to be made any sale of beer to a person under 21 years of age or to allow such person to loiter or stay around the premises without their parent. The burden of ascertaining the age of minor persons shall be on the permit holder and his agent or employee."

You or your employee has been cited by the Mt. Juliet Police Department for selling beer to a minor during a routine compliance check on May 21, 2025. Section 4-79 of the Mt. Juliet City Ordinances provides that the Board may revoke or suspend a permit or offer a permit holder the alternative of paying a civil penalty. Pursuant to T.C.A. § 57-5-108, the civil penalty shall not exceed \$1,000.00 for each offense. However, if a vendor is guilty of selling beer to a minor and the permit holder has failed to achieve responsible vendor status pursuant to T.C.A. § 57-5-606, then this civil penalty is increased to a maximum of \$2,500.00. If a civil penalty is offered, the permit holder shall have seven (7) days within which to pay the civil penalty before the revocation or suspension shall be imposed.

Details:

On 05/21/2025 at approximately 1110 hours, detectives with the Mt. Juliet Police Department's Crime Suppression Unit conducted an on-site alcohol compliance check at Burger Republic Restaurant, (1982 Providence Pkwy).

Utilizing an adult underage confidential informant (CI); detectives provided the CI with \$10.00 of Official Advance Funds (OAF) and briefed the CI about the operation. A short time later, the CI entered Burger Republic and was able to successfully purchase a bottled Bud Light for \$4.39. The CI's ID was not checked and a purchase was made as observed by audio/video recording. Once the transaction was complete, the CI exited the restaurant and described the offender (John Hiter) to detectives. The CI stated the offender was a white male with a curly perm hair style and Burger Republic work attire. The receipt also reflected the sale.

After speaking with the CI and gathering all information, Detective Bates and I entered the establishment and made contact with John. John was subsequently issued a misdemeanor citation for violation of TCA 57-4-203 Prohibited Practices. His booking date was set for Wednesday, June 11th, 2025, at Wilson County Jail. I advised John of the court process and he stated he understood.

RE: Mandatory Appearance Before the Mt. Juliet Alcoholic Beverage Board

Dear Permit Holder:

You are hereby cited to appear before the Mt. Juliet Alcoholic Beverage Board on December 9, 2025, at 5:30 PM. You will have the opportunity to explain the circumstances why your beer permit should not be suspended or revoked for violation of the Mt. Juliet City Ordinances. Specifically, Section 4-70(3):

"Make or permit to be made any sale of beer to a person under 21 years of age or to allow such person to loiter or stay around the premises without their parent. The burden of ascertaining the age of minor persons shall be on the permit holder and his agent or employee."

You or your employee has been cited by the Mt. Juliet Police Department for selling beer to a minor during a routine compliance check on May 21, 2025. Section 4-79 of the Mt. Juliet City Ordinances provides that the Board may revoke or suspend a permit or offer a permit holder the alternative of paying a civil penalty. Pursuant to T.C.A. § 57-5-108, the civil penalty shall not exceed \$1,000.00 for each offense. However, if a vendor is guilty of selling beer to a minor and the permit holder has failed to achieve responsible vendor status pursuant to T.C.A. § 57-5-606, then this civil penalty is increased to a maximum of \$2,500.00. If a civil penalty is offered, the permit holder shall have seven (7) days within which to pay the civil penalty before the revocation or suspension shall be imposed.
