### SYNOPSIS

On 05/09/2024, Agents with the Mt. Juliet Police Department's Crime Suppression Unit (CSU) conducted Compliance Checks throughout the city. The intention of the compliance checks was to confirm that all stores, which served alcoholic beverages for off-site consumption, were conforming to City Municipal Codes and State Laws regarding the sale of alcohol to minors.

Agents with CSU utilized an underage male, who at the time of the compliance check was 20 years – D.O.B. 07/28/2003, as a Confidential Informant (CI). Upon the CI's arrival to a secure location, he was photographed, and his driver's license information and pictures were logged for record-keeping purposes. The CI was provided guidelines on how

the compliance checks were conducted and advised not to lie or embellish his age. Once the CI briefing was complete, Agents were assigned specific tasks and the Compliance Checks began. They are as follows –

- Sgt. Derek Thornhill – Financial Accountability and Documentation
- Cpl. Det. Cameron Hoppe – Citations, Interviews, and Reports
- Cpl. Det. Cameron Hoppe – Primary CI Handler and Digital Evidence Logs
- Cpl. Det. Austyn Dyer – Documentation and scribe
- Investigative Analyst Taylor Givens – RMS Administration, Case Assignments, and Database Administration.

### **DETAILS**

On 05/09/2024 at approximately 12:35 PM Agents with the Mt. Juliet Police Department's Crime Suppression Unit conducted a compliance check at the 7-Eleven– 125 N. Mt. Juliet Rd, Mt. Juliet, TN 37122.

Using an underage, Confidential Informant (CI); Agents provided the CI with \$10.00 of Official Advance Funds (OAF) and was briefed about the operation. A short time later, the CI entered 7-Eleven and was able to successfully purchase a bottled Tall Boy Budlight for \$3.39. The CI's ID was checked but a purchase was still made as observed by audio/video recording. Once the transaction was complete, the CI exited the gas station and described the offender (Javonterious K Starnes) to Detectives.

Soon after, Det. Hoppe and Det. Dyer entered the establishment and made contact with Javonterious K Starnes. Starnes was subsequently issued a misdemeanor citation for violation of TCA 57-5-301 Sales to minors or intoxicated persons prohibited.
