

RESOLUTION -2026

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE AWARD OF THE ON-CALL MAINTENANCE CONTRACTS FOR CONCRETE MAINTENANCE, ROAD RESURFACING, AND TRAFFIC SIGNAL MAINTENANCE AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, the City of Mt. Juliet seeks to maintain the City's infrastructure by utilizing on-call contractors to assist with maintenance tasks that staff cannot perform on it's own; and

WHEREAS, these contracts are related to on-call construction services for concrete maintenance, road resurfacing, and traffic signal maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mt. Juliet has received unit price bids and finds High Grade Construction to be the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for the concrete maintenance, finds AMI to be the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for the road resurfacing, and finds Stansell Electric to be the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for the traffic signal maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mt. Juliet desires to award the maintenance contracts to the Contractors listed above.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Mt. Juliet, Wilson County, Tennessee as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners approves the (1) On-Call Concrete Maintenance Contract with High Grade Construction; (2) On-Call Road Resurfacing Contract with AMI Construction; and (3) On-Call Traffic Signal Maintenance Contract with Stansell Electric Company.

Section 2. Mayor James Maness is hereby authorized to execute the said contracts with the Contractors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED

In case of conflict between this resolution or any part hereof, and the whole part of any existing resolution of the City, the conflicting resolution is repealed to the extent of the conflict but no further.

If any section, clause, or provision or portion of this resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, or provision or portion of this resolution.

This resolution shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
