

**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE BELINDA PARKWAY SIDEWALK, PHASE II PROJECT BY THE CITY OF MT. JULIET FOR THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S (TDOT) UPCOMING TAP GRANT CYCLE**

**Executive Summary**

The project: The Belinda Parkway, Phase II project is a continuation of the Phase 1 project that was completed in 2020 and will extend the sidewalk eastward to S. Rutland Road. The project will construct a 6-foot-wide sidewalk along the north/east side of Belinda Parkway from the Mundy Memorial Park trail entrance to S. Rutland Road and will include a connection to the existing Providence Greenway Trail along S. Rutland

Funding: TDOT's Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) grant covers 80% of the construction costs, with 20% being the City's match for construction. The City will also be responsible for 100% of the costs for design and ROW for the project. The estimated total construction cost is \$2,993,915.00. Therefore, if awarded, the grant would cover \$2,395,132 and the City's match would be \$598,783 for construction. The design cost is estimated to be \$295,000 and the ROW cost is estimated to be \$140,000. Therefore, the City's estimated total cost for the project is \$1,033,783.

Official act: This resolution is to provide formal support for the grant application and the local match required.
