

## **RESOLUTION -2026**

### **A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MT. JULIET, TENNESSEE AND KIMLEY-HORN FOR BID AND CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING AND INSPECTION (CEI) SERVICES FOR THE MT. JULIET ROAD ADA UPGRADES, PHASE 2 PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE AGREEMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mt. Juliet seeks to improve multimodal connectivity and transportation options within the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mt. Juliet is preparing for the construction of Mt. Juliet Road ADA Upgrades, Phase 2 project, which will replace sidewalks on both sides of Mt. Juliet Road between Old Lebanon Dirt Road and Weston Drive with 6-foot-wide ADA compliant sidewalks; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mt. Juliet is presently contracted with Kimley-Horn for the design of the project; and

**WHEREAS**, Kimley-Horn has provided the City of Mt. Juliet with an amendment for bid services and CEI services and to establish fees for the services; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mt. Juliet desires to approve the amendment to the agreement with Kimley-Horn for CEI services.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee as follows:

**Section 1.** The Board of Commissioners approves the Amendment with Kimley-Horn.

**Section 2.** Mayor James Maness is hereby authorized to execute the said Amendment with Kimley-Horn.

### **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**

In case of conflict between this resolution or any part hereof, and the whole part of any existing resolution of the City, the conflicting resolution is repealed to the extent of the conflict but no further.

If any section, clause, or provision or portion of this resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, or provision or portion of this resolution.

This resolution shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
