

## RESOLUTION -2026

### A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MT. JULIET, TENNESSEE, AND THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION (FHWA) FOR THE SAFE STREETS FOR ALL IMPLEMENTATION PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE AGREEMENT

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mt. Juliet seeks to improve roadway safety within the City; and

**WHEREAS**, this grant will be used to implement various safety improvements on Sunset Drive, Providence Trail, W. Division Street, Curd Road, and Nonaville Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mt. Juliet desires to coordinate with FHWA on this grant program and to develop the implementation project; and

**WHEREAS**, FHWA has provided the City of Mt. Juliet with an agreement for the purpose of providing an understanding between the parties of their respective obligations related to the management of the project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mt. Juliet desires to approve the agreement with FHWA for the project.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee as follows:

**Section 1.** The Board of Commissioners approves the Agreement with FHWA.

**Section 2.** Mayor James Maness is hereby authorized to execute the said Agreement with FHWA.

#### **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**

In case of conflict between this resolution or any part hereof, and the whole part of any existing resolution of the City, the conflicting resolution is repealed to the extent of the conflict but no further.

If any section, clause, or provision or portion of this resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, or provision or portion of this resolution.

This resolution shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
