## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2024/2025 BUDGET ORDINANCE 2024-25 TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE TN HIGHWAY SAFETY OFFICE AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR DUI TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT FOR THE MT JULIET POLICE DEPARTMENT

**WHEREAS** the City of Mt. Juliet has been awarded a grant by the TN Highway Safety Office; and

**WHEREAS**, the department will participate in impaired driving countermeasure enforcement; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant will provide funds for additional overnights related to extra enforcement activities and traffic enforcement-related equipment; and

**WHEREAS**, the total grant is \$50,000 split 50%/50% between employee overtime and equipment; and

**WHEREAS**, participation in this grant will provide the funds and resources to the department to enhance DUI enforcement for the Mt. Juliet community; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee as follows:

**Section 1.** The 2024/2025 Budget Ordinance (Ordinance 2024-25) is hereby amended as follows:

**General Fund – Police Department**

Increase the Following Expenditures:

110-42100-112	PD Overtime	\$ 25,000.00
110-42100-312	Small Items of Equipment	\$ 25,000.00

Increase the Following Revenue:

110-33440	TN Highway Safety Grant	\$ 50,000.00
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**Section 2.** The budget ordinance, as amended, is ratified and readopted in all respects and this amendment is incorporated therein.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED:**

**Section 3.** In case of conflict between this ordinance or any part hereof, and the whole or part of any existing ordinance of the City, the conflicting ordinance is repealed to the extent of the conflict but no further.

**Section 4.** If any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance.

**Section 5.** That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law, the public welfare requiring it.
