

## RESOLUTION 12-2025

### RESOLUTION APPROVING THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MT. JULIET, TENNESSEE, AND MIDDLE TENNESSEE ELECTRIC MEMBERSHIP CORPORATION (MTE) FOR THE BECKWITH ROAD UTILITY RELOCATION AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE AGREEMENT

#### Executive Summary

- The project: Constructing turn lanes on Beckwith Road and S. Rutland, which is a “quick start” project to the overall Beckwith Road Widening project.
- Contract: MTE has furnished the City with an estimate and relocation plans showing the cost and manner of relocating these facilities, including engineering, which estimate is in the amount of \$403,126.70, and of which 40% represents the pro-rata share to which MTE is entitled to reimbursement for relocation of utility facilities located on private utility easement, and 60% represents the pro-rata share for relocation of utility facilities located on public highway right-of-way. The City is liable for the relocation of utility facilities located on private utility easement, but is not liable for adjustment of facilities located in publicly owned right-of-way
- Funding: The City is responsible for 40% of the estimated total cost, which equates to \$161,250.68. The City is also responsible for the costs associated with acquiring new MTE easements, which equates to \$50,000. The estimated total cost to the City will be \$211,250.68. The City has budgeted for this in the current capital project budget, so no budget amendment will be necessary.
- Official act: This resolution is to provide formal support of the agreement and to authorize the Mayor to sign the agreement.
