

Executive Summary

The projects: Stoners Creek Interceptor:

Replaces the existing interceptor sewer main that conveys wastewater flow from I-40 to the newly constructed 30-inch interceptor to increase capacity and reduce surcharging of water in the wastewater collection system.

Pleasant Grove Interceptor:

Replaces the existing interceptor sewer main that conveys wastewater flow from the Pleasant Grove Road gravity sewers to the newly constructed 30-inch interceptor to increase capacity and reduce surcharging of water in the wastewater collection system.

North Mt. Juliet Road pocket plan:

Construct approximately 3,000 linear feet of gravity sewer main along North Mt. Juliet Road from NW Rutland Road to Weston Drive and from there to connect to the Stoners Creek interceptor to provide improvements in capacity and service capability for the wastewater collection system.

Contracts: The City has a master agreement in place with WMS. These agreements are to add to that agreement with services related to the survey, design, construction, and administration of the projects.

Funding: This work is paid for with budgeted department funds. The not-to-exceed amount of the attachments to the master agreement do not exceed the current funding.

Official act: This resolution is to provide formal support of the attachments to the master agreement and to authorize the Mayor to sign the attachments.
