RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE MT. JULIET SAFETY ACTION PLAN THAT WAS COMPLETED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION'S SAFE STREETS FOR ALL (SS4A) PROGRAM.

Executive Summary

The Plan: Mt. Juliet was awarded a grant from FHWA to develop a data-driven Safety Action Plan with a goal of reducing roadway fatalities and serious injuries in Mt. Juliet. The plan relies upon both traditional crash data and a community outreach and engagement process to inform a comprehensive safety action plan that utilizes quantitative and qualitative input. Crash data was collected and analyzed to identify commonalities across fatal and serious injury crashes. High Injury Networks (HIN) were developed to identify specific locations where fatal and serious injuries occur most often, providing critical insight to the safety action plan's target locations. A comprehensive set of evidence-based projects and strategies was identified as a part of the data-driven and community-focused plan. Implementation strategies with low-cost, high-impact efforts were developed and prioritized to impact a wider area of the jurisdiction.

Official act: This resolution is to adopt the Mt. Juliet Safety Action Plan.
