**A RESOLUTION DECLARING CITY OF MT. JULIET POLICE DEPARTMENT
SEIZED VEHICLE AS SURPLUS TO BE DISPOSED OF AT GOVDEALS
AUCTION**

WHEREAS, the City of Mt. Juliet Police Department has been awarded, by the court, a vehicle seized in a narcotics investigation; and

WHEREAS, the property is identified as follows:

2009 Honda Fit Vin# JHMGE87459S060279

WHEREAS, the vehicle is 15 years old and in poor condition and no use to the department and;

WHEREAS, the department requests the vehicle be declared surplus and sold on GovDeals and;

WHEREAS, the proceeds from the sale are rightfully Drug Fund revenue and will be deposited accordingly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Mt. Juliet, Wilson County, Tennessee as follows:

1. The property listed is hereby declared to be surplus property.
2. The property shall be listed on the auction site GovDeals for sale to the highest bidder.
3. Proceeds from the sale shall be deemed Drug Fund revenue and deposited as such.
4. The City Finance Director is empowered to execute the documents required to affect this resolution.
5. In the event of no bids, the property may be sold as scrap or discarded as trash.
