<b>WHEREAS,</b> on October 27, 2025, pursuant to Ordinance, the City of Mt. Juliet Board of Commissioners annexed the subject property into the corporate boundaries of the City of Mt. Juliet; and
<b>WHEREAS,</b> T.C.A. § 6-51-104 requires a resolution for the annexation proposed by a property owner; and
<b>WHEREAS,</b> this Resolution shall mirror the intent and effect of Ordinance relative to the annexation of the subject property.
<b>NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED</b> by the City of Mt. Juliet, Wilson County, Tennessee as follows:
<b>Section 1</b> . The City of Mt. Juliet Board of Commissioners hereby resolves to pass Ordinance relative to the annexation of E. Division Street from the existing city limits, at the northwestern property corner of parcel 072 067.00, to a point, approximately 2,293 linear feet, east along E. Division Street
<b>Section 2.</b> In the event of conflict between this resolution or any part hereof, and the whole or part of any existing resolution of the City, the conflicting resolution is repealed to the extent of the conflict but no further.
<b>Section 3.</b> If any section, clause, provision, or portion of the resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of the resolution.
