Details:

On 5/1/2024 at approximately 1430 hours, detectives with the Mt. Juliet Police Department's Crime

Suppression Unit conducted an on-site alcohol compliance check at Dos Sisters, (300 Pleasant Grove Road #365).

Utilizing an adult underage confidential informant (CI); detectives provided the CI with \$10.00 of Official Advance Funds (OAF) and briefed the CI about the operation. A short time later, the CI entered Dos Sisters and was able to successfully purchase a bottled Bud Light for \$5.48. The CI's ID was not checked and a purchase was still made as observed by audio/video recording. Once the transaction was complete, the CI exited the restaurant and described the offender (Brian Barragan) to detectives. The CI stated the offender was a Hispanic male, with tattoos on his neck, and a bowl styled hair cut.

After speaking with the CI and gathering all information, Detective Hoppe and I entered the establishment and made contact with Brian and he matched that description. Brian was subsequently issued a misdemeanor citation for violation of TCA 57-5-301, Sales to minors or intoxicated persons prohibited. His court date was set for Monday, August 19th, 2024, in Wilson County General Sessions Court. I advised Brian of the court process and he stated he understood.
