A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A VERIZON WIRELESS CUSTOMER AGREEMENT UNDER THE STATE OF TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF SERVICES CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the City has reviewed the proposed Verizon Wireless Customer Agreement available through the State of Tennessee Department of General Services contract; and

WHEREAS, participation in the State of Tennessee contract will provide improved pricing and telecommunications services for the City.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee as follows:

Section 1. The Verizon Wireless Customer Agreement under the State of Tennessee contract is hereby approved.

Section 2. The Board hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute the Verizon Wireless Customer Agreement and any related documents necessary to implement the agreement on behalf of the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED

In case of conflict between this resolution or any part hereof, and the whole part of any existing resolution of the City, the conflicting resolution is repealed to the extent of the conflict but no further.

If any section, clause, or provision or portion of this resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, or provision or portion of this resolution.

This resolution shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
