Juliet, TN 37122) directly supports the department's mission to serve and protect the community with excellence. This light tower will enhance visibility and safety during special events, critical incidents, and emergency responses by providing reliable lighting in low-visibility or nighttime environments. It will also serve as a vital tool during crime scene investigations, allowing detectives and officers to properly document, process, and secure scenes in dark or poorly lit areas. This equipment ensures our personnel can work more safely and effectively while improving outcomes for both public safety and investigative efforts. More than just a piece of equipment, this donation reflects the strength of community partnership that helps strengthen the department's capabilities.
