

## RESOLUTION - 2026

### A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A DONATION OF A DIESEL ENGINE PORTABLE LIGHT TOWER FOR THE CITY OF MT. JULIET POLICE DEPARTMENT

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mt. Juliet has been offered a donation by Neal Zabkar; and

**WHEREAS**, the donation is for a 2023 GENERAC brand mobile light tower with a diesel engine Serial/VIN: 3013537194; and

**WHEREAS**, the mobile light tower can be utilized by the Mt. Juliet Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the value of the mobile tower is estimated at \$25,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the City Manager to accept the donated light tower for the Mt. Juliet Police Department,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee as follows:

**Section 1.** The Board of Commissioner accepts the donation from Neal Zabkar of a mobile light tower to be used by the Mt. Juliet Police Department.

### BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED

In case of conflict between this ordinance or any part hereof, and the whole part of any existing ordinance of the City, the conflicting ordinance is repealed to the extent of the conflict but no further.

If any section, clause, or provision or portion of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, or provision or portion of this ordinance.

This ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
